MCMOW ART GLASS, Lake Worth

You don't need to be a Louis Comfort Tiffany to enjoy working with stained glass. Consider the benefits: Your colorful creation will look great at home, you'll enjoy the relaxed pace of the work, and you won't spend much.

In fact, the Beginner's Stained Glass class at McMow Art Glass costs just \$55. For this, you receive 15 hours of instruction. (Class meets five times, once a week, for three hours.) You also receive a discount on supplies.

In the beginner's class, students learn how to cut and shape glass, how to apply copper foil and then solder, and how to assemble their stained-glass panel.

Other classes include Direct-Method Mosaics and Intermediate Lead Came Lab (a "came" is a divider bar used between small pieces of glass)

Maybe you won't become the next Louis C. Tiffany — but who knows? He began as a painter but is best remembered for his stained-glass creations.
